# USING A PRESTO TICKET

 A PRESTO Ticket must be tapped on a PRESTO reader on a TTC vehicle or in a station. A person's tapped ticket is their Proof-of-Payment on the TTC

# FARE TYPES AND PRICE

- Single ride youth, adult, senior tickets are available
- PRESTO tickets are priced the same as TTC tokens and tickets

# TWO-HOUR TRANSFER

 PRESTO Tickets provide people with a two hour transfer which means that they can enter and exit the TTC as much as they would like within two hours without being charged another fare







## **ID REQUIREMENTS**

ID rules similar to TTC tickets are applicable:

- Youth 16 19 must show proof of age
- Seniors 65+ must show proof of age

### **EXPIRY**

 Valid for up to 5 years as printed on the ticket

### **MORE INFOMATION**

- PRESTO Tickets cannot be reloaded with rides
- PRESTO cannot track the identity of the ticket holder
- You can check a PRESTO
   Ticket to see if it still has a
   ride available at a PRESTO
   Self-serve machine
